All bids must be in the Office of the Purchasing Division, 201-C West Gray St., Norman, Oklahoma, 73069, BEFORE THE FINAL CLOSING HOUR as shown on the Invitation to Bid. If bid is mailed, to be considered it should be addressed as follows: Attention: Purchasing Division, Opening of Bids, City of Norman, P.O. Box 370, Norman, Oklahoma, 73070. In addition, the bid envelope should be plainly marked on both sides indication the bid number.

The unit price must be stated on all items and all totals extended, if required. BIDDER GUARANTEES UNIT PRICE TO BE CORRECT. To receive consideration, bids must be submitted on the City of Norman "Form for Bidders" and "Bidders Proposal" (if applicable), which are hereby made part of this Invitation to Bid.

Alternate bids may be considered. If bidding an alternate, so state on the face of the Form for Bidders and fully describe the merchandise and include Manufacturer's literature. Unless the bidder identifies on the Form for Bidders that an alternate is being bid, the vendor will be expected to deliver merchandise as specified. Alternate bids shall not be submitted to circumvent the specifications.

## 1.0 Services:

This contract is a firm fixed price requirements contract for Automotive Body Repair on various fleet services vehicles including but not limited to police cars, up to 2-ton trucks, sedans, pick-up trucks, and trailers. Work will be done on an as needed basis, and vehicles may be picked up at the Fleet Management Facility at 1301 Da Vinci, Norman, OK, 73070. Upon completion, vehicles will be delivered to the Fleet Management Facility.

#### **2.0 Employee Background Check:**

Contractor's employees will be subject to the City of Norman Police Department background check. Failure of an employee to successfully pass the background check may be grounds for contract termination. Contractor shall notify the Fleet Services supervisor of contractor's new employee hires so background checks can be conducted.

#### 3.0 Notification, Pickup and Delivery:

The City of Norman Fleet Management representatives will notify Contractor that he/she has a vehicle needing repairs and the Contractor will pick-up the vehicle at the Fleet Management Facility within four (4) hours of notification. The Contractor shall start work on the vehicle within one (1) working day of receipt of the vehicle. Parts delays shall be the only acceptable reason for the need to exceed the start time.

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#### **4.0 Priorities:**

Time is of the essence in returning City of Norman vehicles to service. The Contractor agrees that Emergency Equipment (Police/Fire) work assigned under this contract shall receive priority over other work in its shop unless specific prior approval has been obtained from the City of Norman. If the City of Norman agrees that the workload of a contractor is such that timeliness is not possible in a given situation, the City of Norman reserves the unilateral right to assign the job to a backup contractor. Repeated assignments to a backup contractor may result in contract termination.

#### **5.0 Estimates:**

The Contractor shall write an estimate to repair the vehicle in accordance with the bid price for parts and labor (due within 8 working hours after vehicle pick-up). The estimate shall indicate

labor and/or parts cost by component. Contractor shall call the City Fleet Management representative and notify him/her of the amount of the estimate and hand carry, email, or fax him/her a copy. The Contractor shall state in the repair estimate, the total turn around time for the repairs in the estimate.

## Estimating must provide the following information:

- Date of Estimate Date the estimate is being provided.
- Customer Name Include Address, and Phone Number
- Vehicle Description Include year, make, model, body style, complete (17) digit VIN number, license number, odometer & hour meter if applicable, color, and City of Norman unit number.
- All repair or replacement times in hours or tenth of hours.
- Part description Detail whether the part fits on left or right side of vehicle, front or rear, and the specific name. Include Part Number assigned by the manufacturer, suggested retail price of the part, and quality of parts offered: New, Used, etc.
- Paint materials, their cost, and the allowed labor hours

#### **6.0** Equipment and Facilities:

The facility and equipment shall conform to all applicable city, county, state and federal rules, regulations, codes and laws. Contractor facility must be able to provide a fenced secured lot and a building security system for City of Norman vehicles while in their possession. The vehicle must be stored in a secured storage area or building and the vehicle must be locked at all times when not being serviced.

The Contractor shall have the following equipment at the repair facility:

- 6.01 A heated spray paint booth that is in legal compliance with all applicable laws. Contractor must be able to paint and repair a wide variety of vehicles used in municipal applications. Including but not limited to police cars, up to 2 ton trucks, sedans, pick-up trucks, and trailers. Contractor shall also have the following painting related equipment:
  - Painter's fresh air supply system with mask.
  - Portable drying system.
  - Computerized production system (for mixing paint, measuring quantities, and the ability to provide computer print out documentation of measurements).

- 6.02 A frame/unibody dedicated bench system with straightening capabilities. The Contractor shall have adequately trained personnel to use the unibody bench system. The bench system shall be capable of making multiple body and structural pulls for straightening. Contractor shall also have the following equipment:

- 6.03 An air conditioning Freon recycling and charging station. The contractor shall have employees certified to use this equipment. This equipment shall meet all state and federal requirements for Freon recycling.
