The City Council of the City of Norman, Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma, met in Special Session at 5:38 p.m. in the Municipal Building Conference Room on the 5th day of February, 2019, and notice and agenda of the meeting were posted in the Municipal Building at 201 West Gray and the Norman Public Library at 225 North Webster 48 hours prior to the beginning of the meeting.
