**Item No. 3 being: Update on Winter Warming Shelter**

The Warming Shelter has been open nightly since December 6.

- 104 individuals logged since opening; 80 of those were not on the by name list. 6 of those 80 are veterans and are now on housing plans.
- Clorox wipes are still needed for the Warming Shelter.
- PIT (Point in Time Count) is January 23. There will be a training for volunteers on January 15, 5:30pm-7pm at the Norman PD briefing room. Another will be held on January 21, 1pm-2:30pm in the multipurpose room of the City Municipal building.
- Flashlights and reflective vests are needed for PIT.

**Item No. 4 being: New Business**

- CM Scanlon hosted a ward meeting where Sutton Wilderness was discussed. Parks has been cleaning up the park, but it is ongoing.
- The City Council can review the ordinances surrounding parks and camping on public property. Could a permitting system for campers help?
- A placeholder fund can be placed in the budget for a permanent day shelter.
- The committee will begin to look for potential locations for a day shelter.
