#### Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 11:33 a.m. Attendees were logged into Zoom for the virtual meeting. Board members took turns introducing themselves; they also provided updates regarding their respective jobs and organizations.

#### **Minutes**

Minutes from the May meeting were presented. Green moved to approve the minutes, Gillis made the second for the motion. Motion was approved.

#### **Finance Report**

Schemm presented the financials via screen share (Mark Milsap, former-treasurer, recently resigned). He pointed out the \$30,000 PPE loan (to be paid back 2021). Otherwise, guest tax collections down drastically (in fact, there were no collections in May). We have received some refunds due to canceled work trips, etc., but certainly not enough to offset any "losses." Schemm continues to explore other means of financial support--including additional SBA loans (based on Hatter's input).

Allison and Hall both expressed appreciation for Schemm's leadership and fiscal conservatism during this time.

Compagni moved to approve the financial statement, Allison seconded the motion; the measure passed.

#### **Covid-19 Updates**

Schemm explained that the Travel Industry is in a *depression* (not recession)--showing 51% unemployment--9 times worth than the impact that 9/11 had immediately following that attack.

• #OKHereWeGo - Schemm additionally reported that VisitNorman will be participating in the State's efforts to reboot the economy. Among those applicable to our office: road trips, staycations, #eatNORMAN Restaurant Week, etc.

#### FY 2021 Budget

Passed by City Council on June 16.

#### FY 2021 VisitNorman Board of Directors

Currently two openings due to resignation of Milsap and Leemaster. Green moved to approve Schemm's nominations of Amber Beutler and Emily Chancellor to the board; Gillis seconded. Motion approved unanimously.

#### **Norman Forward/Sports Commission**

Schemm will attend next week's meeting at City Hall as the future of Norman Forward continues to be discussed. Hatter and Allison explained that if we do *not* proceed, then investors and builders may be discouraged to do future business in Norman.

Paperwork for the VisitNorman Sports Commission to be officially established as a 501c3 organization has been submitted. VisitNorman will meet with hotel partners soon to further discuss TMD.
