- There should not be an increase in the cleaning fees from the company under contract. Michelle factored in extra funds for masks, toilet paper, etc. that the cleaning company does not provide.
- There was discussion about adding a bus stop at Industrial and Rock Creek. Lisa K. will ask Taylor in Public Works.

Item No. 5 being: Encampments

- Parks is touring Sutton Wilderness weekly checking for encampments with none noted.
- There is an encampment on the Nazarene Church property adjacent to Sutton Wilderness. The Church agreed to post vacate signs, and there will be a clean-up effort initially scheduled for today but due to weather, will most likely be rescheduled.
- There is a continuing expansion of the encampment at Carter & Alameda. No signs have been posted, but the property owners have a meeting with the City Manager scheduled.
- Cary will contact ODOT about the River encampment.

• There was also discussion about the difficulties in housing level 3 sex offenders, and opening up communications with the Department of Corrections and surrounding communities to help facilitate this problem.
