CENTRAL SQUARE TECHNOLOGIES, LLC, ET. AL., U.S. DISTRICT COURT, WESTERN DISTRICT, CASE NO. CV-2020-500 G AND AS AUTHORIZED UNDER OKLAHOMA STATUTES TITLE 25 §307(B)(3) TO DISCUSS THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED GENERALLY AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF FLOOD AVENUE AND ROBINSON STREET FOR THE JAMES GARNER EXTENSION PROJECT AND REAL PROPERTY IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE 36TH AVENUE N.W. WIDENING BOND PROJECT.

INFORMATION: Pursuant to 25 O.S., Section 307(B)(4), a public body is permitted to conduct an executive session to discuss confidential communications between the body and its attorney concerning a pending investigation, claim, or action if the public body, with the advice of its attorney, determines that disclosure will seriously impair the ability of the public body to process the claim or conduct a pending investigation, litigation, or proceeding in the public interest. Furthermore, pursuant to 25 O.S., Section 307(B)(3) a public body is permitted to conduct an executive session to discuss the purchase or appraisal of real property. Thereupon, this item is submitted for City Council's consideration.
