I have watched the Council Position for Ward 2 for a very long time and have seen it only rarely filled by a citizen engaged in actively accomplishing the needs of Ward 2. My goal in representing the citizens of Ward 2 would be to know their needs, understand their needs in the larger context of the City of Norman and find ways to work with other Council Members and constituents to accomplish those needs. In addition, I believe it to be important to provide a clear path of communication from the citizens of Ward 2 to the Norman City Council and also, equally importantly, a clear path of communication from the Norman City Council to the citizens of Ward 2. I believe that many of the largest challenges Norman has faced in the last 20 years could have been better communicated to the citizens of Norman and as a consequence, the citizens would have been better able to make informed decisions and understand that the Council makes informed and carefully considered decisions. I believe the work of being a City Council Member is important, and has a direct impact on the quality of life for Norman and all its citizens. I believe it is incumbent on citizens to do their share, whether being an informed voter or a hard working Council Member.

Do you have any direct or indirect financial or economic interest in any business or other undertaking (whether for profit or non profit) coming before City Council? NO If yes, please explain.
Not at this time, with the exception of my involvement as a Board Member for Sooner Swim Club and its interest in the indoor aquatic center. If selected, I would likely step down from the Swim Club Board, for the simple reason that I believe I will need to focus all my available spare time on the City Council.
