Item 4. Discussion regarding establishing public finance for City Council candidates.

Ms. Hall said at the Joint City Council Oversight Committee (CCOC) and Norman Election Commission (NEC) meeting on May 2, 2012, Councilmember Kovach asked the NEC to review establishing public finance for City Council candidates and forward information and recommendations to City Council. She said Councilmember Kovach felt that there are potential candidates that might run for City Council if they had the means to finance a campaign. She said in similar programs if a candidate opts in for public finance, they cannot accept contributions from individuals. She said NEC Chairman Ty Hardiman is currently researching the subject and wants the item scheduled for discussion on the NEC's agenda in June when they meet to review final candidate campaign reports for Ward 8. Vice-Chairman Hilbert said Ms. Mary Francis, former NEC Chair, is an authority on public finance and Ms. Hall said Chairman Hardiman would be contacting Ms. Francis for further information.
