A. Bike Lanes

Members discussed a list of streets for potential lane striping. It was mentioned that 60% of the community must approved a street for non-parking status. Focus was on streets meeting criteria a) on bike plan, b) having non-parking status, and c) on OU property. Mr. Lombardo offered to create a matrix of the streets meeting different criteria.

Streets agreed upon for lane striping: Oaktree, Creekdale, DL Boren, Parkside, Findlay, and Walnut.

C. Motorist complaint

A related matter is the Bicycle League of Norman's (BLN) Tuesday ride that seems to attract controversy. Mr. Miller will discuss the ride with the BLN about the ride being rerouted.
