Fire Department Report

Chief Fullingim reported that Fire Station No. 9 is almost finished.

Chief Fullingim reported that City Council in the upcoming year will be discussing what we as a community can do to be more prepared for disasters.

Police Department Report

Lt. Keesee reported there are currently 17 police vacancies. The Police Department has completed the annual Safety Town Program at Sooner Mall. They have updated the COP Annual Work Plan for 2014. They are currently conducting a citizen satisfaction survey. There are seven cadets in the current academy. The graduation will be July 25th followed by field training until November.

They have been taking applications for police officers since April 1st. The next academy will be in October.

The COP activity for May was 60 hours partnerships, 82 hours problem solving and 392 hours education for a total of 534 hours.
