DISCUSS WATER CONSERVATION PUBLIC EDUCATION

Nairn stated that the Yard of the Month was advertised in the Norman Transcript. No entries were received. She stated there were a couple of options. We could extend it or start it up later but have additional advertising. The Board decided it was too late in the year to start. Abbot made a motion to postpone Yard of the Month. Pilat seconded. There being no further discussion, a vote was taken with the following result:

Nairn stated that the City is planning to amend the Water Conservation Plan and go to odd/even watering year round. Nairn has a proposed letter to the Mayor and Council supporting this. There are 5 stages proposed. Some members had concerns regarding the mandatory odd/even days. It is difficult for people with sprinkler systems to set up odd/even. Sprinkler systems are usually set up by the day of the week and it can be complicated to do. Four days a week would be better than odd/even for that reason. A couple of minor revisions to the letter were suggested.
