1) 12<sup>th</sup> Ave SE Widening (Oak Tree to Cedar Lane) - bike lane connections to existing bike lane on Oak Tree and Cedar Lane Rd.

- 2) State Hwy Multimodal Path (24thSE 36th SE Ave) Phase I first mile of Hwy 9 with 10-foot concrete surface on northside of road.
- 3) Pavement markings a) Road diet Rock Creek (48<sup>th</sup>NW Grandview Ave) 4-land to 3-lane with bike lanes b) Main St (48<sup>th</sup> NW Cherry Creek Dr) similar treatments

RFP is being drafted for the two selected TAP projects (YAY!!!) 1) Constitution and 2) Hwy 9 (Phase II) (36<sup>th</sup> SE – 48<sup>th</sup> SE)
