



Angelo Lombardo – reminded the committee that roads are designed to a certain speed and simply reducing the speed limit actually doesn't reduce the speed. They will look at the 85% speeds/speed study for the road to determine if it is feasible to reduce the speed limit.

Pursuing a multiuse path –with amendment to CTP – may be the more likely pathway to connect the bike lanes on other sections of 24thSE with the section that was designed/built before the CTP was in place.
