This is a Rural Certificate of Survey plat for two 10 acre lots for single family residential use. The WQPZ was removed, floodplain remains, and no trails cross the lots.

Applicant: Varenna Landing LLC

Project: Varenna Landing Subdivision

Location: Near E. Lindsey St. & 24th Ave. SE

Request: Preliminary Plat
Land Use: Residential

This is a Preliminary Plat for 87 single family residential lots. There is WQPZ and floodplain that is incorporated into the site plain. There is a school and park within a half mile of plat, and there is currently no pedestrian connection. Sidewalks will be required. WQPZ might be scaled down. To the North is a future addition of Summit Lakes which will tie into Varenna Landing. The applicant stated they are planning to put sidewalks along the streets, plant trees along sidewalks for a street tree canopy, and possibly add a trail through the common area. The Board complemented them on the street tree canopy, trail and connection to adjacent future subdivisions.
