Item No. 1, being: Introductions.

Item No. 2, being: Update on the City of Norman CDBG and HOME Programs

- The tree planting project will focus on the Original Townsite neighborhood this year.
- CDBG is partnering with Habitat for Humanity to build accessible ramps.
- HOME, with the CHDO, purchased several lots upon which houses will be built for more affordable housing options.

Item No. 3 being: Discussion of the Issues Facing Low and Moderate Income Households in Norman

- Transportation, specifically to medical appointments.
- The need for affordable housing.
- The need for evening day care past 6pm for working families.
- Mental health issues, and the possibilities of the Porter campus.
- Homelessness and the city's efforts, including the warming shelter and the need for a permanent day shelter.
- The need for more code enforcement officers.
- A discussion about streets, sidewalks, and the need for a covered bus stop at Rose Rock.
