○ **City of Norman Updates:**

- James Briggs, CoNParks: Discussion of the planned pump track and that will not be at the new skatepark.
- David Riesland, Norman Transportation initiatives: painted Bike lanes install completed on West Main. December meeting to review and move forward on construction of Multi-Modal path along Highway 9 from East 36th to 48th. Planned 2020 Norman street construction projects. 24th street SE work has commenced and should take 18 months or so.
- Thomas Zermeno NPD: Football and parade seasons are coming up and the Norman PD bike team will be busy. Thomas is interested in doing educational work and George and Sarah volunteered to assist in recruiting participants.
- City of Norman: via Taylor Johnson, public transit coordinator for Norman. Norman is running its own bus service -- 652 bikes transported in November.
- Crimson Cruisers: OU will discontinue for 2020. 2545 trips on Crimson Cruisers in November. 454 hours with 2710 trips. Bicycles to be replaced by e-bikes.
- Thomas Zermeno, NPD: No bicycle specific details. Discussed recent spate of package thefts
- Committee as whole discussed and worked on central Oklahoma bike map and on the Bicycle Friendly Community application due in Early 2020.
