### ITEM NO. 6 BEING: Miscellaneous Discussion

Miscellaneous Discussion consisted of:

- Mark and George look forward to meeting with City Council regarding Article 21, Rights and Responsibilities of Greenbelt Commission.
- There has been a lack of engagement with developers in the City. The hope is to educate and gather information with a survey, possibly, that could be included with the forms that are filled out by the developers during the application process. The Commission does not wish to be "just another hoop" for developers to jump through, rather the desire is a collaborative effort with developers. Commission wishes to identify developers that have the opportunity to make an impact, target their input.
- State Law is limiting potential trail system expansion, due to property laws including lot lines up to the middle of the river in some areas. The feeling is property owners do not want strangers wandering on their land, thus limiting our ability to construct trails along Little River, etc.
- Commissioners will brainstorm ways to increase community and developer education regarding ways to improve/encourage our Trail System development.
