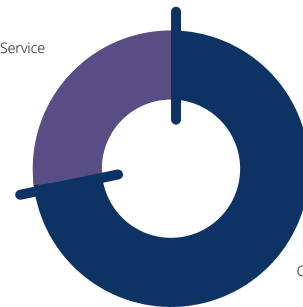

WEEK IN REVIEW

- NPD ARRESTS ONE IN CONNECTION TO A STABBING IN THE 2100 BLOCK OF W. BROOKS ST ON MARCH 22. THE VICTIM WAS TREATED FOR NON-LIFE THREATENING INJURIES. THE INCIDENT STEMMED FROM A DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE.
