Commissioned Disqualifiers



Please read the following disqualifiers carefully. If any of the following apply, you will not be qualified to participate in the hiring process. A polygraph will be given during the selection process using these same questions, as well as others. If you have any questions, please contact the Police Employment Tech at 405-366-5495.

Chief's Automatic Disqualifiers-

- _____ Individual has been placed on a Brady list in any jurisdiction
- _____ The applicant has been arrested for any impaired driving offense within the **two years** prior to the date the agency began accepting applications.
- _____ The applicant has been arrested (with charges filed) for a crime within the last **two years** prior to the date the agency began accepting applications
- _____ The applicant has unlawfully used/sold or produced any CDS within the **five years** prior to the date the agency began accepting applications. (This does not include marijuana or prescription drugs)
- _____ The applicant has used Marijuana, marijuana metabolites or THC products ***with*** a license within **six months** prior to the date their application was submitted.
- _____ The applicant has used Marijuana, marijuana metabolites or THC products ***without*** a license within **one year** prior to the date their application was submitted.

* Marijuana, whether it is used medically or recreationally, remains a violation of the Federal Controlled Substances Act, 21 U.S.C. §§ 801 et seq.

State Law

- _____ Applicant has a FBI or OSBI record of a conviction of a felony, a crime of moral turpitude, or domestic violence. **(70OS3311(E)(1),(a)(b)(J)(1)(a-b),(E)and(J)(5)(F))**
- _____ Applicant has received a verdict of guilt or entered a plea of *nolo contendere*, or is participating in a deferred sentence, for a felony, a crime involving moral turpitude or a domestic violence offense. **(70OS3311(E)(1),(e) (J)(1)(c),and(J)(6)(F))**
- _____ Applicant is subject to an order of the Council (CLEET) revoking, suspending, or accepting a voluntary surrender of their peace officer certification. **(70OS3311 (E) (1), (f) (F))**
- _____ Applicant has voluntarily surrendered and relinquished their peace officer certification to CLEET within five (5) years of the date of this application. **(70OS3311 (J) (10) (a))**

- _____ Applicant has had their police or peace officer certification from another state revoked or voluntarily surrendered within five (5) years of the date of this application. *(70OS3311 (J) (1) (e), and ((J) (10) (b))*
- _____ A psychologist licensed by the State of Oklahoma within one (1) year of application has found applicant unsuitable for employment or certification. *(70OS3311 (E) (2) (a))*
- _____ Applicant does not possess a high school diploma or a GED equivalency certificate. *(70OS3311 (E) (1), (d))*
- _____ Applicant is under 21, or more than 45, years of age prior to certification as an officer. *(11OS50-112(A)), and 70OS3311 (E) (h))*
- _____ Applicant cannot provide proof of United States citizenship or resident alien status. *(70OS3311 (E) (1) (i))*
- _____ Applicant has willfully misrepresented information in an employment application, application to the Council (CLEET), records of evidence, or in testimony under oath. *(70OS3311 (J) (1) (d))*
- _____ Applicant is currently undergoing treatment for a mental illness, condition or disorder. For purposes of this subsection, "currently undergoing treatment for mental illness, condition or disorder" means the person has been diagnosed by a licensed physician, psychologist, or licensed mental health professional as being afflicted with a substantial disorder of thought, mood, perception, psychological orientation or memory that significantly impairs judgment, behavior, capacity to recognize reality, or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life and such condition continues to exist. *(70OS3311 (E) (1), (g) (J) (7))*
- _____ Applicant has an interest, financial or otherwise, in a wrecker or towing service, or with a person or in a business that derives business or income from a wrecker or towing service. *(47OS72 956(C))*

Federal Law

- _____ Applicant has been convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year. *(18USC922 (g) (1))*
- _____ Applicant is a fugitive from justice. *(18USC922 (g) (2))*
- _____ Applicant is an unlawful user to any controlled substance. *(18USC922 (g) (3))*
- _____ Applicant has been adjudicated as a mental defective or who has been committed to a mental institution. *(18USC922 (g) (4))*
- _____ Applicant, being an alien, is illegally or unlawfully in the United States; or has been admitted to the United States under a nonimmigrant visa. *(18USC922 (g) (5))*
- _____ Applicant has been discharged from the Armed Forces under dishonorable conditions. *(18USC922 (g) (6))*
- _____ Applicant, having once been a citizen of the United States, has renounced his citizenship. *(18USC922 (g) (7))*

- _____ Applicant is subject to a court order that restrains the applicant from harassing, stalking, or threatening an intimate partner or child of an intimate partner. *(18USC922 (g) (8))*
- _____ Applicant has been convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence. *(18USC922 (g) (9))*
