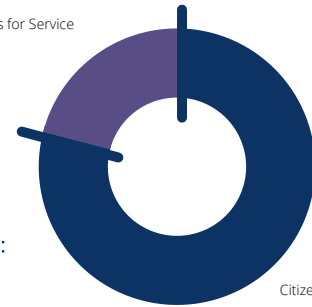

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A SHOOTING WITH MULTIPLE FATALITIES AND A SUSPECT AWAITING TO ENGAGE OFFICERS. THE RESPONSE AND INVESTIGATION DETERMINED THE ORIGINAL CALL WAS NOT VALID. WE APPRECIATE THE ASSISTANCE AND COOPERATION FROM ALL THOSE THAT WERE INVOLVED.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE PARTNERED WITH *FRIENDS FOR FOLKS* TO SEND 5 DOGS TO LEXINGTON PRISON FOR THEIR DOG TRAINING PROGRAM. THE PROGRAM PAIRS HOMELESS ANIMALS WITH INMATES FOR A 6-WEEK INTENSIVE TRAINING COURSE. UPON COMPLETION, THE DOGS WILL RETURN TO NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE SO THEY CAN BE ADOPTED INTO THEIR FOREVER HOMES.
