## WEEK IN REVIEW

- Officers responded to a shooting on cook ave. they contacted NUMEROUS JUVENILES AT A PARTY. OFFICERS LOCATED 2 UNINJURED JUVENILES NEARBY, BUT DID NOT FIND THE SUSPECT. HOURS LATER, ANOTHER shooting at the same location was reported. officers contacted the SUSPECT AS HE WAS TRYING TO LEAVE AND PLACED HIM in CUSTODY. investigation revealed the suspect was intoxicated, held a gun to the HEAD OF ANOTHER PERSON, AND MADE NUMEROUS THREATS TO KILL THEM.
- npd Communications received a car-jacking call on n. porter ave. the VICTIM, AN UBER DRIVER, HAD A DISTURBANCE WITH A PASSENGER. THE DRIVER STEPPED OUT, AND THE PASSENGER MOVED TO THE FRONT SEAT BEFORE driving away, RUNNING OVER the Victim's FOOT AND kNOCKING HER TO the ground. the vehicle was found a short time later by officers, and the SUSPECT WAS PLACED INTO CUSTODY
- COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED ANOTHER CAR-JACKING CALL NEAR NE 12TH AND robinson st. the victim said they were told to get out of their vehicle OR THEY WOULD BE SHOT. THE VICTIM GOT OUT, AND THE SUSPECT DROVE OFF WITH THE VEHICLE. A SHORT TIME LATER, OFFICERS FOUND THE CAR AND OTHER OFFICERS NOTICED A PERSON MATCHING THE SUSPECT'S DESCRIPTION. THE PERSON IMMEDIATELY FLED. THE CASE REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION. - OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A BURGLARY IN PROGRESS ON CLASSEN BLVD. UPON ARRIVAL, OFFICERS NOTICED FORCED ENTRY AND INITIATED A SEARCH INSIDE the business. THE SUSPECT WAS FOUND, TAKING PROPERTY, AND PLACED INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT.
