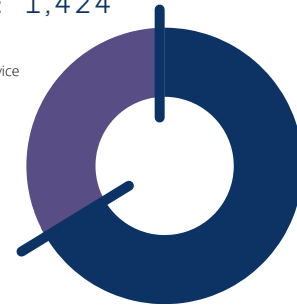

- WHILE INVESTIGATING AN ONLINE SCAM, NPD INVESTIGATORS UNCOVERED CONNECTIONS TO AN OUT OF STATE SUSPECT WHO WAS POSSIBLY INVOLVED IN ADDITIONAL CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES. THE ONGOING EFFORT EVENTUALLY RESULTED IN IDENTIFICATION OF ADDITIONAL VICTIMS AND POSSIBLE STOLEN FUNDS LOCATED ACROSS MULTIPLE STATES. THE INVESTIGATION HAS BEEN REFERRED TO FEDERAL PARTNERS FOR FURTHER ACTION.
