## **Tree Story:**

Describe a tree at your home, in your neighborhood, at your school, or around Norman, and construct a narrative from the point of view of the tree. The story should incorporate observations on the surrounding environmental influences on the tree. Examples include but are not limited to construction around the tree, wildlife, competition for light and nutrients from other trees, environmental hazards, insect infestations, or evidence of storm or fire damage.

## Tree Art:

Include an original piece of art inspired by your tree story. Art can be in any form like photography, painting, or drawing. Sculptures are accepted but will judged from the uploaded image.

\*The Tree Story and Artwork must be original and student-created.

## **Submissions:**

The Norman Tree Board will accept entries from October 16, 2023 to January 31, 2024. All submissions must be received or postmarked by 11:00 PM January 31, 2024 to be considered. Entries can be submitted online, emailed, or mailed. All submissions must include the student's name, a parental contact, name of school, grade level, and homeroom teacher's name.

Submissions will be judged by the Norman Tree Board based on creativity, originality, and observation skills. Winners will be announced in April 2024 and recognized at the Norman Tree Board booth at the City's annual Earth Day celebration.
