 Chair Gordon mentioned a Freedman exhibit at the Cherokee
 Heritage Center; Member Bingham suggested exploring the
 Oklahoma Alliance for Geographic Education's resources
 - February- African American cultural celebration
 - April- Asian American and Pacific Islander cultural celebration
 - Local artists (members of Hispanic, Indigenous, African American, and Asian American and Pacific Islander communities) invited to work in the library space and works displayed
