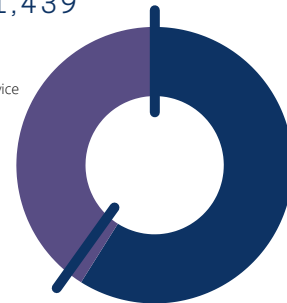

WEEK IN REVIEW

- A CITIZEN TIP LED TO THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE SUSPECT IN A REPORTED ASSAULT THAT OCCURRED IN THE 500 BLOCK OF BUCHANAN AVE ON 3/1. THE VICTIM REPORTED THAT SHE WAS PUNCHED IN THE FACE BY AN UNKNOWN MALE WHO THEN LEFT THE AREA. CHARGES ARE PENDING AS THE CASE REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- MEMBERS OF THE UNCREWED AERIAL SYSTEMS TEAM TOOK PART IN A MAJOR LEAGUE DRONE RACING EVENT ON 3/16. THE CHARITY RACE RAISED FUNDS FOR THE TOBY KEITH FOUNDATION AND OK KIDS KORRAL. NPD LED THE MAJORITY OF THE EVENT BUT FELL BEHIND LATE YIELDING THE VICTORY TO MPD.
- TWO NPD OFFICERS RECENTLY COMPLETED DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERT (DRE) SCHOOL. THE ADVANCED TRAINING PROVIDES OFFICERS ADDITIONAL TOOLS AND SKILLS TO RECOGNIZE IMPAIRED DRIVERS AND FURTHER ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS TO REDUCE TRAFFIC HARMS IN NORMAN.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 27 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 7 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER, AND 6 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED OUT TO RESCUES THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 76 ANIMALS INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 147 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 23 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
