#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- DURING THE WEEK COMMUNITY OUTREACH CONDUCTED MULTIPLE CRIME PREVENTION FORUMS, ATTENDED A NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH-GROUP MEETING, PERFORMED A CRIME PREVENTION THROUGH ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN (CPTED) SURVEY, AND MET WITH BUSINESSES TO PROMOTE CRIME REDUCTION, SAFETY, AND SECURITY.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN APPARENT ACCIDENTAL SHOOTING IN THE 3400 BLOCK OF 108TH AVE SE ON 3/23. ONE INDIVIDUAL WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- ANIMAL WELFARE PARTNERED WITH *DOG IS MY COPILOT* AND TRANSFERRED 33 ANIMALS FROM OUR SHELTER TO RESCUE ORGANIZATIONS IN THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST WHO WERE IN NEED OF ADOPTABLE ANIMALS.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HOSTED ITS FIRST MIDNIGHT MUTTNESS COMMUNITY EVENT WHERE THE SHELTER STAYED OPEN FOR ADOPTIONS UNTIL MIDNIGHT. THE EVENT WAS A HUGE SUCCESS AND RESULTED IN 21 ANIMALS FINDING THEIR FOREVER HOMES.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 35 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 12 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER, AND 34 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED OUT TO RESCUES THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 63 ANIMALS. THE SHELTER CURRENTLY HAS 127 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 29 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
