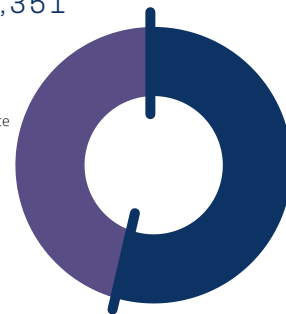

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF 36TH AVE SW AND RIVERWALK DR ON 4/22. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT A MOTORCYCLIST WAS DRIVING NORTH ON 36TH WHEN THEY LOST CONTROL OF THEIR MOTORCYCLE CAUSING THEM TO BE STRUCK BY ANOTHER VEHICLE. THEY WERE TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL WHERE THEY WERE LATER PRONOUNCED DECEASED. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CIRT.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION IN THE 5500 BLK OF W. ROBINSON ON 4/26. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT A VEHICLE HIT A BICYCLIST BEFORE LEAVING THE SCENE AND THEN CAUSING SEVERAL ADDITIONAL INJURY COLLISIONS IN THE AREA. OFFICERS LOCATED THE INVOLVED VEHICLE NEARBY. THE DRIVER WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT. HE WAS BOOKED INTO CCDC ON COMPLAINTS OF MANSLAUGHTER - FIRST DEGREE, LEAVING THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT INVOLVING INJURY (TWO COUNTS), LEAVING THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT WITH FATALITY, AND DUI. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CIRT.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 37 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 3 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED TO RESCUES, AND 6 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. THEY ALSO TOOK 71 ANIMALS INTO THE SHELTER. THERE ARE 143 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 46 OF THOSE ANIMALS IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
