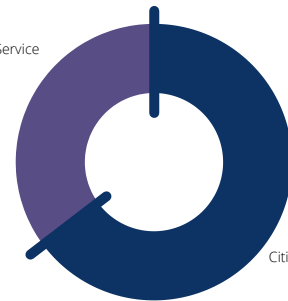

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS ATTEMPTED TO INITIATE A TRAFFIC STOP ON A VEHICLE DRIVING ERRATICALLY IN THE AREA OF DOVE CROSSING DR AND N. INTERSTATE DRIVE ON 8/13. THE VEHICLE STOPPED IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROADWAY AND ITS FOUR OCCUPANTS FLED THE AREA. OFFICERS CONFIRMED THE VEHICLE AS STOLEN. OFFICERS ESTABLISHED A PERIMETER AND TOOK THREE OF THE FOUR JUVENILE OCCUPANTS INTO CUSTODY. THE FOURTH WAS IDENTIFIED AND A WARRANT WAS REQUESTED.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION AT INDIAN HILLS RD AND 156TH AVE NE ON 8/12. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT A MOTORCYCLE TRAVELING WESTBOUND ON INDIAN HILL DID NOT STOP AT A STOP SIGN AND COLLIDED WITH A TRUCK TRAVELING NORTHBOUND ON 156TH AVE NE. THE DRIVER DIED AS A RESULT OF INJURIES SUSTAINED IN THE COLLISION. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS ARRESTED ONE FOR DOMESTIC ABUSE BY STRANGULATION AND DUI FOLLOWING A DISTURBANCE CALL IN THE 2300 BLOCK OF TAHOE DRIVE ON 8/17. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CID.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN ACCIDENTAL SHOOTING THAT OCCURRED IN THE 3000 BLOCK OF STEPHEN ROAD ON 8/17. INVESTIGATORS CONFIRMED THE SHOOTING TO BE ACCIDENTAL IN NATURE. ONE JUVENILE WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL WITH A MINOR GRAZE WOUND ON AN EXTREMITY.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 41 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 1 ANIMAL TRANSFERRED TO RESCUE, AND 14 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 86 ANIMALS. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 212 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 80 OF THOSE ANIMALS IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
