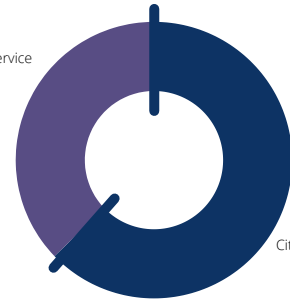

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- DISPATCH RECEIVED A CALL FROM A LOCAL HOTEL ON 08/20 WITH THE CALLER REPORTING THEIR CAR HAD JUST BEEN STOLEN FROM WITH THEIR 11 Y/O CHILD ASLEEP IN THE VEHICLE. THE CHILD WAS RECOVERED NEARBY (AFTER BEING DROPPED OFF BY THE SUSPECT), AND THE SUSPECT WAS CONTACTED BY OHP ON I-35. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED FOR LARCENY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE AND KIDNAPPING.
- DISPATCH RECEIVED SEVERAL CALLS FOR SHOTS HEARD AT THE APARTMENTS IN THE 1100 BLK OF E. BROOKS ST ON 08/24. A CLEVELAND COUNTY DEPUTY NOTICED A COUPLE ARGUING NEAR A VEHICLE FOLLOWED BY GUNSHOTS. THE DEPUTY MADE EYE-CONTACT WITH THE MALE SUBJECT WHO IMMEDIATELY FLED. WHEN NORMAN OFFICERS ARRIVED, THEY DETAINED THE MALE SUBJECT, LOCATED 4 SHELL CASINGS NEAR THE VEHICLE, AND FOUND A GUN IN THE NEARBY. FURTHER INVESTIGATION SHOWED THE GUN WAS REPORTED STOLEN. THE MALE SUBJECT WAS ARRESTED AND TAKEN TO THE CLEVELAND COUNTY DETENTION CENTER.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 45 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 6 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 65 ANIMALS AND CURRENTLY HAVE 208 IN THEIR CARE WITH 74 OF THOSE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
- NORMAN POLICE DEPARTMENT INVESTIGATED A KIDNAPPING/ROBBERY INCIDENT ON 08/20 INVOLVING AN ELDERLY VICTIM WHO HIRED A CONTRACTOR TO RENOVATE HER PROPERTY. DURING THE INCIDENT, THE CONTRACTOR ASSAULTED THE VICTIM AND FORCED HER TO PAY HIM FOR SERVICES HE HAD NOT YET PROVIDED. OFFICERS AND DETECTIVES TRACKED DOWN THE SUSPECT, THEN INTERVIEWED HIM ABOUT THE INCIDENT. HE WAS SUBSEQUENTLY BOOKED INTO CCJC ON MULTIPLE FELONY CHARGES.
- THE P.A.C.E. SECTION AND CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS SECTION CONDUCTED A JOINT OPERATION WITH CCISO, GARVIN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, NORMAN REGIONAL EMSSTAT, AND THE DRAGONFLY HOME. THIS OPERATION WAS TARGETED TO ADDRESS HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND WAS A PART OF THE NATIONWIDE DETAIL KNOWN AS "OPERATION COAST TO COAST". THE GOAL OF THE OPERATION WAS TO IDENTIFY TRAFFICKING VICTIMS AND OFFER SERVICES TO THEM, WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY ARRESTING THE TRAFFICKERS. DURING THE OPERATION, 3 INDIVIDUALS WERE OFFERED SERVICES AND 2 OTHERS WERE ARRESTED.
