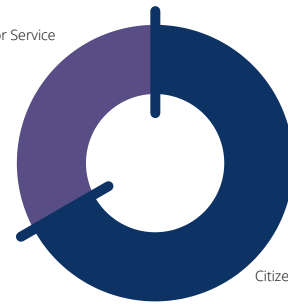

WEEK IN REVIEW

- NPd WAS REQUESTED FOR MUTUAL AID TO ASSIST THE CLEVELAND COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN THEIR RESPONSE TO A SHOOTING WITH MULTIPLE SCENES ON 10/11. NPd OFFICERS ASSISTED WITH WORKING THE SCENE PERIMETER AND TAKING THE SUSPECT INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORTED STABBING IN THE 200 BLK OF REED AVE ON 10/11. THE VICTIM HAD BEEN STABBED MULTIPLE TIMES BUT WAS INITIALLY UNCOOPERATIVE AND SEVERELY INTOXICATED. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT OF NON-LIFE THREATENING INJURIES. OFFICERS WERE ABLE TO LATER DEVELOP ADDITIONAL INFORMATION. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- THE OKLAHOMA ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE PRESENTED SGT. STEVENSON WITH A MEDAL OF VALOR ON 10/8 FOR HIS HEROIC ACTIONS WHEN RESPONDING TO HIS PARTNER WHO WAS SHOT DURING AN ATTEMPTED TRAFFIC STOP ALONG I-35 IN OCTOBER 2023.
- NPd OFFICER -- LT. WISHON -- DEPLOYED ON 10/7 AS PART OF A STATE INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM TO FLORIDA IN RESPONSE TO HURRICANE MILTON. THE TEAM SERVED IN SUPPORT OF INCIDENT COMMAND IN FLORIDA BEFORE RETURNING ON 10/13.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE PARTNERED WITH "DOG IS MY COPILOT" ON 10/7 SENDING 28 ANIMALS ON A FLIGHT TO A RESCUE ORGANIZATION IN OREGON.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 37 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 30 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED TO RESCUE, AND 5 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN 35 ANIMALS. THEY CURRENTLY HAVE 163 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 43 OF THOSE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
