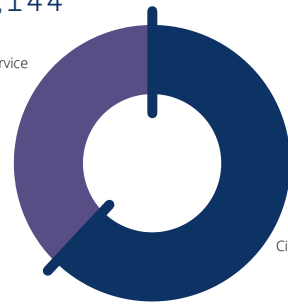

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO REPORT OF A VEHICLE IN THE DITCH IN THE 7100 BLK OF E. FRANKLIN RD. ON 11/18. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED THE VEHICLE IN A THE CREEK WITH ONE OCCUPANT WHO WAS DECEASED FROM INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE INCIDENT. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE DRIVER/SOLE OCCUPANT DROVE OFF THE ROADWAY AND INTO THE CREEK. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OU PD CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING IN THE 200 BLK OF REED AVE ON 11/19. TWO SUBJECTS WERE INVOLVED IN A DISTURBANCE WHEN ONE OF THEM FIRED MULTIPLE SHOTS AT THE OTHER BEFORE FLEEING THE AREA. NO ONE WAS HIT AND NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CID.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A ROBBERY OUTSIDE OF A BUSINESS IN THE 500 BLK OF N. PORTER ON 11/23. THE VICTIM REPORTED A SUBJECT PULLED A KNIFE ON THEM AND STOLE THEIR BICYCLE. NOBODY WAS INJURED AND THE SUSPECT WAS NOT FOUND. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A DOMESTIC ASSAULT IN THE 1700 BLK OF E. LINDSEY ST. ON 11/24. OFFICERS OBSERVED INJURIES CONSISTENT WITH ASSAULT AND REQUESTED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED ON MULTIPLE CHARGES RELATED TO THE ASSAULT.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING IN THE 1300 BLK OF CROWN POINT AVE. ON 11/25. INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT DURING THE COURSE OF A DISTURBANCE ONE SUBJECT WAS STABBED. SHOTS WERE ALSO FIRED AT THE BUILDING. NO ONE WAS HIT BY GUNFIRE. ALL INJURIES ARE NON-LIFE-THREATENING. ALL INVOLVED PARTIES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 54 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 29 TRANSFERRED TO RESCUE, AND 26 RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN 114 ANIMALS AND HAVE 120 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE - 30 ANIMALS ARE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS. THE SHELTER PARTNERED WITH "DOG IS MY COPILOT" ON 11/21 AND FLEW 26 DOGS TO OREGON.
