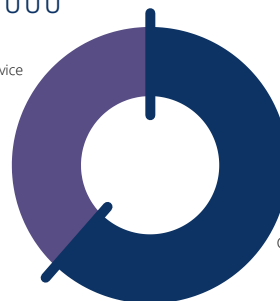

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A DISTURBANCE WITH A FIREARM IN THE 900 BLK OF 24TH AVE SW ON 12/18. INITIAL REPORTS WERE THAT THE SUSPECT HAD THREATENED TO SHOOT ANOTHER RESIDENT. THE SUSPECT WAS LOCATED OUTSIDE OF THEIR RESIDENCE AND DETAINED. WITNESSES HEARD THE SUSPECT MAKE THREATS, SAW A GUN, AND HEARD GUNSHOTS. OFFICERS REQUESTED A SEARCH WARRANT AND FOUND THE GUN INSIDE THE SUSPECT'S RESIDENCE. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED FOR MULTIPLE OFFENSES.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A STABBING IN THE 3000 BLK OF WISTER RD ON 12/25. A DISTURBANCE BETWEEN TWO INDIVIDUALS KNOWN TO ONE ANOTHER WAS OCCURRING WHEN THE SUSPECT STABBED THE VICTIM IN THE FACE AND BACK. THE SUSPECT FLED BEFORE OFFICERS ARRIVED, THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL FOR NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES. INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SINGLE VEHICLE COLLISION IN THE 3900 BLK OF CHAUTAUQUA AVE ON 12/26. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED A SINGLE OCCUPANT WHO WAS DECEASED. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE COLLISION OCCURED THE PREVIOUS DAY WHEN THE DRIVER LEFT THE ROADWAY AND COLLIDED WITH A POLE. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CIRT.
- OFFICERS WERE CALLED TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING IN THE 2400 BLK OF W. BROOKS ON 12/26. UPON ARRIVAL, OFFICERS LOCATED A SINGLE VICTIM WITH A GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE ABDOMEN. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL. INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE SHOOTING OCCURRED DURING A DISTURBANCE. BOTH SUSPECTS FLED BEFORE OFFICERS ARRIVED. THE CASE REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 77 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 4 TRANSFERRED TO RESCUE, AND 8 RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN 95 ANIMALS. THERE ARE CURRENTLY 134 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 16 OF THOSE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
