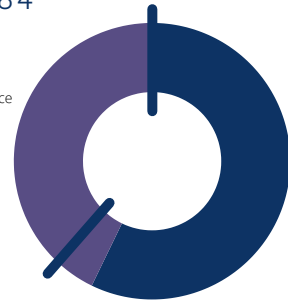

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING IN THE 3400 BLOCK OF PORTER AVE ON 12/29. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION DETERMINED THAT AN UNKNOWN INDIVIDUAL HAD SHOT AT ANOTHER VEHICLE IN THE PARKING LOT. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED A SHELL CASING AND A BULLET HOLE IN TWO OTHER VEHICLES. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN INJURY COLLISION INVOLVING TWO VEHICLES AT SH-9 AND CHAUTAUQUA AVE ON 1/1. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED ONE VEHICLE WITH A SINGLE OCCUPANT WHO WAS UNRESPONSIVE AND TRAPPED. THE OTHER INVOLVED VEHICLE HAD TWO OCCUPANTS WHO REPORTED MINOR, NON-LIFE THREATENING INJURIES. NFD WAS ABLE TO EXTRACT THE UNRESPONSIVE VICTIM WHO WAS THEN TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL IN CRITICAL CONDITION. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE VEHICLES TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND ON CHAUTAUQUA AVE. DID NOT STOP FOR A RED TRAFFIC SIGNAL, STRIKING THE OTHER VEHICLE THAT WAS EASTBOUND ON SH-9 IN THE INTERSECTION. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY NPD/OU/D CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED A SHOOTING IN THE 900 BLK OF BILOXI DR ON 1/2. INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT TWO INDIVIDUALS FIRED MULTIPLE SHOTS IN THE PARKING LOT OF THE APARTMENT COMPLEX STRIKING A RESIDENTIAL BUILDING AND SEVERAL PARKED VEHICLES. NO ONE WAS INJURED DURING THE INCIDENT. OFFICERS ARE FOLLOWING LEADS TO LOCATE THE INVOLVED SUSPECTS. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 35 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 1 TRANSFERRED TO RESCUE, AND 12 RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN 57 ANIMALS TO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER. THEY CURRENTLY HAVE 133 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 17 OF THOSE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
