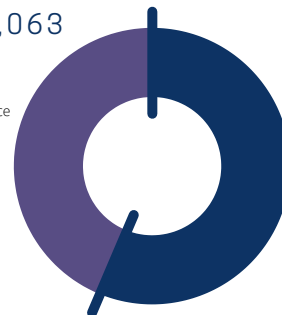

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS ARRESTED ONE ON A WARRANT FOR MURDER (SECOND DEGREE) AND BOOKED HER INTO CCDC ON 2/5. OFFICERS WERE CONTACTED BY MEDICAL STAFF AT A LOCAL HOSPITAL REGARDING A CHILD THAT HAD BEEN BROUGHT INTO THE FACILITY WITH A SIGNIFICANT HEAD INJURY ON 1/7. DUE TO THE SEVERITY OF THE INJURIES, THE CHILD WAS AIR FLIGHTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL WHERE THEY LATER SUCCOMBED TO THEIR INJURIES. THE INVESTIGATION DETERMINED THE MOTHER WAS INTOXICATED AND LEFT THE CHILD UNATTENDED FOR APPROXIMATELY 1.5 HOURS DURING WHICH TIME THE CHILD SUFFERED FATAL INJURIES. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO REPORT OF A ONE-YEAR-OLD CHILD FOUND IN THE ROADWAY IN THE 2000 BLOCK OF W. LINDSEY AT APPROXIMATELY 5AM ON 2/8. OFFICERS CANVASSED THE AREA IN ATTEMPTS TO FIND ANYONE LOOKING FOR A CHILD OR AN OPEN/ABANDONED RESIDENCE. WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE PUBLIC THROUGH SOCIAL MEDIA, THE CHILD WAS IDENTIFIED AND THE PARENT LOCATED AT APPROXIMATELY 8AM. BASED ON THE INVESTIGATION INTO THE INCIDENT, THE PARENT WAS ARRESTED AND BOOKED INTO CCDC ON COMPLAINTS OF CHILD NEGLECT, POSSESSION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, AND DESTROYING EVIDENCE. THE JUVENILE WAS TAKEN INTO PROTECTIVE CUSTODY.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 40 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 2 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN 51 ANIMALS INTO THE CENTER THIS WEEK. CURRENTLY, THEY HAVE 114 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 25 OF THOSE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
