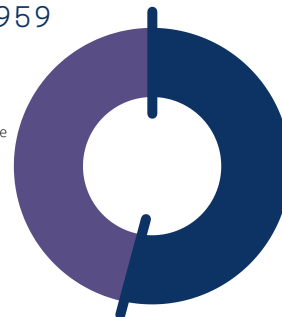

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A MULTI-VEHICLE COLLISION ON I-35 NEAR LINDSEY STREET ON 2/14. SEVERAL INDIVIDUALS WERE TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL WITH NON-LIFE THREATENING INJURIES. RESPONSE TO THE COLLISION RESULTED IN SIGNIFICANT IMPACTS TO TRAFFIC ON BOTH NORTH AND SOUTHBOUND I-35. OHP IS INVESTIGATING THE COLLISION.
- NPD RESPONDED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL IN REGARD TO A REPORTED ASSAULT THAT OCCURRED IN THE EARLY MORNING HOURS OF 2/15 IN A PARKING LOT IN THE 500 BLOCK OF BUCHANAN AVE. THE VICTIM HAD ARRIVED AT THE HOSPITAL WITH A SIGNIFICANT HEAD INJURY. ALL INVOLVED PARTIES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AND ARE COOPERATING WITH THE ONGOING INVESTIGATION. INVESTIGATORS ARE SEEKING ANYONE WHO MAY HAVE WITNESSED THE FIGHT. ANYONE WITH INFO OR VIDEO IS ASKED TO REPORT IT TO NPD AT 405-366-5449 OR THROUGH NORMAN CRIME STOPPERS.
- SIX NEW OFFICERS GRADUATED FROM THE 67TH NORMAN POLICE ACADEMY ON 2/14. THEY WILL TRANSITION INTO FIELD TRAINING BEFORE RECEIVING THEIR ASSIGNMENT ON PATROL.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 29 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 2 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 54 ANIMALS INTO THE CENTER. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 121 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 27 OF THOSE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
