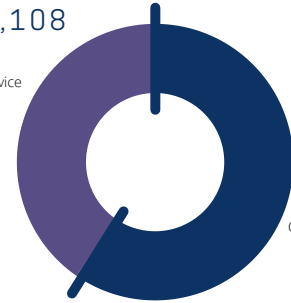

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS WORKED TO PROVIDE PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES THROUGH THE EXTREME COLD AND ICE WEATHER EVENT ON 2/18 THROUGH 2/20. DURING THIS WEATHER EVENT, OFFICERS RESPONDED TO 17 MOTORIST ASSISTS, 9 NON-INJURY COLLISIONS, AND 2 INJURY COLLISIONS.
- OFFICERS PROVIDED MUTUAL AID BY ESTABLISHING A SCENE PERIMETER AFTER OKCPD PURSUED A STOLEN VEHICLE INTO NORMAN. THE PURSUIT ENDED NEAR 24TH AVE SW AND BROOKS STREET. BOTH SUSPECTS WERE TAKEN INTO CUSTODY.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A DRIVE-BY SHOOTING IN THE IN THE 1400 BLK OF 24TH AVE SE ON 2/22. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT A VICTIM WAS CARRYING BAGS FROM THEIR CAR INTO AN APARTMENT WHEN AN UNKNOWN SUSPECT SHOT AT THEM FROM A VEHICLE. THE VICTIM WAS STRUCK IN THE LEG. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR NON-LIFE THREATENING INJURIES. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 29 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 6 RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 43 ANIMALS THIS WEEK. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 123 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 27 OF THOSE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
