(E-Waste)

We are committed to helping you dispose of your old electronics responsibly.

At this time, the Household Hazardous Waste Facility (HHWF) is unable to accept electronics, but we plan to host at least one electronic waste collection event annually, with the goal of semi-annual spring and fall events. Event details will be announced on our website, shared on social media, and included in utility bill notices—so stay tuned for updates!



Our recycling contractor has confirmed that most items with a cord will be accepted, with the exception of refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners. These items contain Freon, which must be properly removed before disposal. *(For more information on how to dispose of items with Freon, please visit the “Scrap Metal & White Goods” link on our homepage.)*

Ink cartridges, CDs, video tapes, cables, cords, and batteries will be accepted at these events.



If you cannot wait until our next event, the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) provides a list of convenient recycling resources. We recommend contacting the recyclers listed, as some may charge fees.
