We are delighted to offer a Self-Serve Station right here at the Household Hazardous Waste Facility (HHWF), where Norman residents can conveniently and responsibly dispose of motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, and cooking oil at no cost. The Self-Serve Station is located on the west side of the HHWF and is accessible through the west parking lot. Simply drive through the gate of the Complex, take the first left, and follow the drive around to the west side. You do not need an appointment to use the Self-Serve Station, but we do monitor it, so please have your City of Norman utility bill (water/trash bill) and driver's license available. We do have a limit of **5 gallons per item, per day**.



- Please note, at this time, the Self-Serve Station is only for Norman residents who are disposing of personal waste. We cannot accept commercial, industrial, or institutional waste.
- Please use the correct tanks and the trashcans provided. Pouring unauthorized material in the tank will contaminate the entire tanking making it unable to be recycled.
- If you have other automotive fluids besides motor oil and antifreeze, please make an appointment at the Household Hazardous Waste Facility for proper disposal.

We request that you help us maintain this area by following the posted guidelines, cleaning up after yourself, and refraining from leaving containers, whether full or empty, on the ground or placing them in the oil filter bin. If you happen to find a tank full, please do not hesitate to notify us by calling the HHWF at 405.366.5463. If this is the case, we recommend returning at a later time to dispose of your items. Your cooperation in keeping the area clean and efficient is greatly appreciated.
