

The Swap Shop

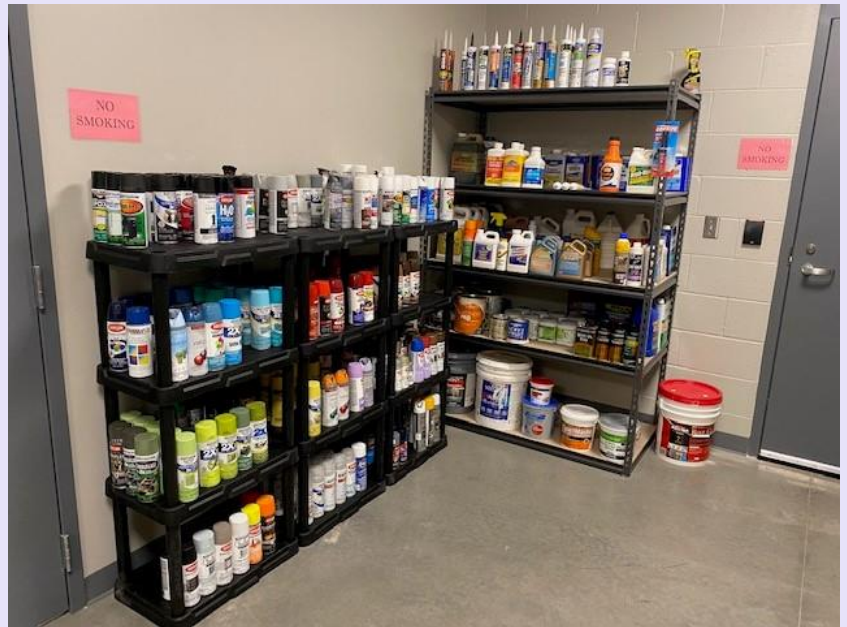
Please be aware that you do need an appointment to visit the Swap Shop and these appointments are scheduled separate from disposal appointments.



At the Household Hazardous Waste Facility (HHWF), we are committed to environmental protection and supporting our community in every possible way.

One of our initiatives is the Swap Shop, where you can contribute and benefit.

When items are brought in for disposal, they go through the processing stage where they are sorted into the appropriate hazard categories for disposal. During this process, we may find items that are still in usable condition. These items are inspected for four things: the condition of the container, the presence of labels, whether there is enough product to be useful, and if the item is expired, recalled, or banned.



Items that pass inspection are cleaned up and placed in the Swap Shop, where residents can make an appointment to shop at no cost. Requesting a Swap Shop appointment is as straightforward as scheduling a disposal appointment and it follows the same process.

Let us work together to reduce additional waste by bringing our own reusable shopping bags when visiting the Swap Shop.
