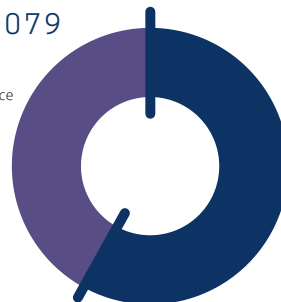

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN INJURED INDIVIDUAL IN A PARKING LOT IN THE 300 BLK OF E BOYD STREET ON 3/2. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED AN ADULT MALE WHO APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN INVOLVED IN A PHYSICAL ALTERCATION. THE INDIVIDUAL WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL WHERE HE LATER SUCCEDED TO HIS INJURIES. THE INVESTIGATION INTO WHAT PRECEDED OUR RESPONSE IS ONGOING. INVESTIGATORS ARE CURRENTLY WORKING TO DETERMINE THE SPECIFIC CAUSE OF THE PERSON'S INJURY, THE NATURE OF THE ALTERCATION, AND WHAT MAY HAVE LED UP TO IT. ALL INDIVIDUALS BELIEVED TO BE INVOLVED HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AND CONTACTED BY INVESTIGATORS. ALL ARE COOPERATING WITH THE ONGOING INVESTIGATION.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A MUTUAL AID REQUEST FROM MOORE PD ON 3/5. MOORE OFFICERS WERE PURSUING A VEHICLE BEING DRIVEN BY A SUBJECT WITH A FELONY WARRANT. THE PURSUIT WAS TERMINATED BUT OFFICERS FOUND THE SUBJECT RUNNING ACROSS INTERSTATE DR TOWARD THE SCHOOL IN THE 5000 BLOCK OF N. INTERSTATE DRIVE. OFFICERS FROM MOORE AND NORMAN SEARCHED THE AREA AND FOUND THE SUBJECT HIDING UNDER A SCHOOL BUS. THE SUBJECT WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY BY MOORE PD WITH NO FURTHER INCIDENT.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING CALL IN THE 3900 BLK OF STONEWELL CT ON 3/7. THE REPORTING PARTY SAID THAT THEIR PARENTS WERE ARGUING AND THEY THEN HEARD A GUNSHOT AND A "THUMP" ON THE GROUND. OFFICERS QUICKLY RESPONDED, ESTABLISHED A SECURE PERIMETER, AND MADE CONTACT WITH THOSE INSIDE. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE CALL WAS FICTITIOUS AND APPARENTLY THE RESULT OF A DISAGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPORTING PERSON AND A JUVENILE RESIDENT OVER AN ONLINE GAME. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 55 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 13 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER, AND 2 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED OUT TO RESCUE. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 63 ANIMALS INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER THIS WEEK. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 128 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 21 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
