

Safety Guidelines



Due to the hazardous nature of the materials we handle, we implement a high level of safety protocols. Our main priority is your and our staff's safety. Your cooperation in following our safety guidelines is essential for the smooth operation of the Household Hazardous Waste Facility (HHWF).

Please DO NOT cross chains to enter the building. Only certain areas in the facility are available to the public – Our safety protocols do not allow for an open-to-the-public facility. Residents are only able to enter certain areas of the facility and never without supervision or the appropriate Personal Protection Equipment (PPE).

Participants must be at least 18 years of age – Due to the nature of the materials we handle and the necessary forms required for each disposal, participants must be 18 years of age or older to bring household hazardous waste items to the facility.

Please follow all posted signage – We share the complex with the Transfer Station, so there can be heavy traffic at any time, including trash trucks and semi-trucks coming and going from various directions. Additionally, due to the nature of our work, certain areas around the complex, primarily around the HHWF, are restricted.

Please respect the restricted areas – These areas are work zones. Entering these zones can quickly create a hazardous situation for everyone involved.



Please DO NOT block entrances or drives -- Trash trucks and semi-trucks may need to take different routes to enter and exit the Transfer Station. Please avoid parking in entrances and driveways to help them navigate the complex more easily.

Please remain in your vehicle – Please remain in your vehicle at all times upon arrival for your disposal appointment. This is to ensure the safety of both you and our staff.

Please DO NOT arrive early for your appointment – Please refrain from pulling up to the door earlier than your scheduled appointment time to avoid disrupting another individual's appointment. If you happen to arrive early, we suggest waiting in the Recycle Center, conveniently situated directly south of the HHWF. This is a safe and suitable area for early arrivals to wait

Please avoid honking to gain attention – We are equipped with mirrors, cameras, and sensors to monitor arrivals. Honking can startle us, leading to potential accidents, especially during chemical processing.

We appreciate your understanding and patience as we maintain a safe and efficient environment for everyone.
