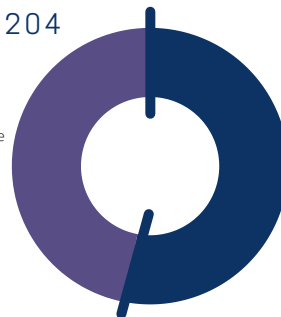

WEEK IN REVIEW

- A SILVER ALERT WAS ISSUED FOR AN AT-RISK 77-YEAR-OLD MALE ON 3/19. THE INDIVIDUAL WAS REPORTED TO HAVE SHORT TERM MEMORY ISSUES AND PARKINSON'S. HE HAD BEEN MISSING SINCE APPROXIMATELY 12:30PM THAT DAY. JUST BEFORE MIDNIGHT, THE INDIVIDUAL WAS LOCATED SAFE.
- PATROL AND INVESTIGATIONS PARTNERED TO LOCATE A 12-YEAR-OLD RUNAWAY JUVENILE. THE JUVENILE HAD RUN AWAY FROM A RESIDENCE IN THE 800 BLOCK OF LEXINGTON ST ON 3/16. OFFICERS LOCATED THE MALE SAFE ON 3/20. INVESTIGATORS ARE COMPLETING FOLLOW-UPS REGARDING THE INCIDENT.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 15 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 8 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 53 ANIMALS INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER THIS WEEK. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 145 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 16 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
