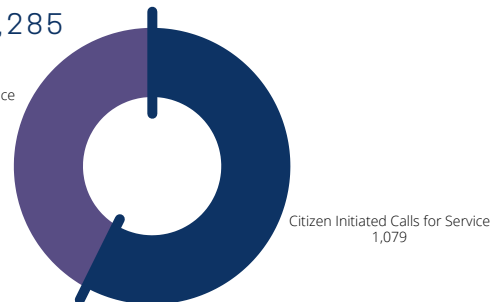

WEEK IN REVIEW

- INVESTIGATORS RECENTLY ARRESTED ONE IN CONNECTION WITH A SHOOTING THAT OCCURRED IN THE 900 BLOCK OF BILOXI DRIVE ON 01/02. ONE INDIVIDUAL WAS ARRESTED AND BOOKED INTO CCDC ON CHARGES OF DISCHARGING A FIREARM INTO A DWELLING AND 3 COUNTS OF ASSAULT AND BATTERY WITH A DANGEROUS WEAPON. THE INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT DURING AN ALTERCATION MULTIPLE ROUNDS WERE FIRED IN THE DIRECTION OF SEVERAL INDIVIDUALS IN THE AREA. THE APARTMENT BUILDING AND MULTIPLE VEHICLES WERE STRUCK. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN EMERGENCY CALL FOR HELP IN THE 200 BLK OF W. HADDOCK ST ON 04/02. A SUBJECT WITH BLOOD ON THEIR FACE WAS BANGING AT THE CALLER'S DOOR ASKING FOR HELP. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATED THAT ONE FAMILY MEMBER WAS STABBED BY ANOTHER FAMILY MEMBER DURING A DISTURBANCE. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED AND TRANSPORTED TO CCDC ON COMPLAINTS OF ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON AND MAKING THREATS OF VIOLENCE. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT OF NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 20 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 16 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 55 ANIMALS INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER THIS WEEK. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 138 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 26 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
