### WEEK IN REVIEW

- PATROL RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF ROAD RAGE INVOLVING A FIREARM IN THE AREA OF LINDSEY ST AND CLASSEN BLVD ON 8/25. THE VICTIM SAID THAT AN INDIVIDUAL ON A MOTORCYCLE PULLED A GUN ON THEM FOR UNSPECIFIED REASONS AND THEN LEFT THE AREA. OFFICERS CONTACTED BOTH THE VICTIM AND THE SUSPECT AND REVIEWED ADDITIONAL INFO. OFFICERS ARRESTED THE SUSPECT FOR TREATENING A VIOLENT ACT.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A COLLISION INVOLVING A VEHICLE AND PEDESTRIAN IN THE DROP-OFF LINE OF A SCHOOL IN THE 600 BLK OF MEADOW RIDGE RD ON 8/26. OFFICERS LOCATED A JUVENILE WITH INJURIES. THE CHILD WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL AND TREATED FOR NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OU PD CRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A COLLISION INVOLVING A VEHICLE AND PEDESTRIAN NEAR ROBINSON AND FLOOD ON 8/27. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE PEDESTRIAN RAN IN FRONT OF ONCOMING TRAFFIC AS HE WAS ATTEMPTING TO GET TO A VEHICLE STOPPED IN THE INSIDE LANE OF THE ROADWAY. THE JUVENILE WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA FOR NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES.
- NP D ANNOUNCED THE ADDITION OF AN ELECTRONIC STORAGE DETECTION K9 NAMED MURPHY. THE K9 HAS THE ABILITY TO DETECT ELECTRONIC STORAGE DEVICES DURING SEARCHES SUCH AS CELL PHONE, HARD DRIVES, USBS, TABLES, AND OTHER MEDIA. BY HELPING INVESTIGATORS LOCATE VITAL EVIDENCE, MURPHY ENHANCES OUR ABILITY TO BRING OFFENDERS TO JUSTICE AND PROTECT VULNERABLE VICTIMS.
