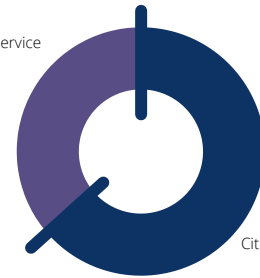

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SINGLE VEHICLE COLLISION IN THE 200 BLK OF 156TH AVE NE ON 9/21. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE VEHICLE LEFT THE ROADWAY FOR UNKNOWN REASONS AND FLIPPED. THE FOUR INDIVIDUALS INSIDE THE VEHICLE WERE INJURED. FIRST RESPONDERS WERE ABLE TO EXTRACT THE PASSENGERS WHO WERE ALL TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OUFD CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A COLLISION INVOLVING A VEHICLE AND TRAIN AT THE CROSSING ON FRANKLIN RD ON 9/25. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT A VEHICLE OCCUPIED BY ONLY THE DRIVER WAS STUCK ON THE TRACKS. WITNESSES SAW THE APPROACHING TRAIN AND PULLED THE DRIVER FROM THE VEHICLE PRIOR TO THE COLLISION. THE DRIVER WAS ARRESTED FOR DUI.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A COLLISION INVOLVING A TRUCK PULLING A TRAILER AND A MOTORCYCLE IN THE AREA OF CEDAR LANE RD AND 84TH AVE SE ON 9/27. THE MOTORCYCLIST WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OUFD CIRT TEAM.
- NPD COORDINATED AND PARTICIPATED IN CLASH FOR A CAUSE ALONGSIDE OTHER CLEVELAND COUNTY FIRST RESPONDERS. THE EVENT FEATURED A KICKBALL TOURNAMENT AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH EVENT THAT RAISED MORE THAN \$14,000 FOR THE LOCAL NON-PROFIT FOSTERING FUTURES.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 46 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 10 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS. THEY ALSO TOOK IN 67 ANIMALS THIS WEEK. THEY HAVE 218 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 56 OF THOSE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
