WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A COLLISION INVOLVING A VEHICLE AND PEDESTRIAN AT CEDAR LANE RD. AND CLASSEN BLVD. ON 9/28. INITIAL INFORMATION INDICATES THAT THE PEDESTRIAN WAS RUNNING ACROSS CLASSEN BLVD WHEN THEY WERE STRUCK BY THE VEHICLE. THE PEDESTRIAN WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOPITAL FOR TREATMENT. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OUFD CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A HEAD-ON COLLISION NEAR LINDSEY ST. AND 24TH AVE. SW ON 10/1. THE DRIVERS OF BOTH INVOLVED VEHICLES WERE TRANSPORTED TO AREA HOSPITAL FOR SIGNIFICANT INJURIES SUSTAINED IN THE COLLISION. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CIRT.
- AN OFFICER OBSERVED A POSSIBLE INTOXICATED DRIVER ON 10/3 IN THE AREA OF LINDSEY ST. AND 24TH AVE. SE. WHEN THE OFFICER ATTEMPTED TO MAKE CONTACT, THE VEHICLE FLED AND CONTINUED TO DRIVE RECKLESSLY. THE VEHICLE ATTEMPTED TO STRIKE OTHER OFFICERS WHO WERE ASSISTING BEFORE CRASHING IN THE 1200 BLK OF E. BOYD ST. THE DRIVER THEN FLED AND THE VEHICLE WAS IDENTIFIED AS STOLEN. THE INVESTIGATION INTO THE INCIDENT IS ONGOING.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A DISTURBANCE CALL IN THE 4400 BLK OF W. MAIN ST ON 10/3. A WOMAN COULD BE HEARD ON AN OPEN LINE SCREAMING FOR HELP. OFFICERS ARRIVED AND SAW A MALE SUSPECT RUN FROM THE HOUSE. THE SUSPECT WAS DETAINED AFTER A SHORT CHASE. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED AND THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT OF INJURIES. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CID.
