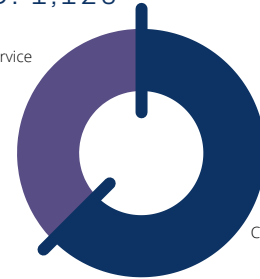

WEEK IN REVIEW

- THE PACE UNIT CONDUCTED AN UNDER 21 PROJECT WHERE OFFICERS FOCUSED ON BUSINESSES SELLING NICOTINE PRODUCTS TO UNDERAGE INDIVIDUALS. DURING THE PROJECT, FOUR BUSINESSES ILLEGALLY SOLD THESE PRODUCTS AND WERE CITED.
- PATROL RESPONDED TO A REPORTED SHOOTING IN THE 2000 BLK OF W. LINDSEY ST ON 10/11. INITIAL INFORMATION INDICATES THAT ONE INDIVIDUAL WAS SHOT DURING A DISTURBANCE. ONE INDIVIDUAL WAS TREATED AT AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE INCIDENT. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CID DIVISION.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 32 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 5 RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN 60 ANIMALS THIS WEEK. THERE ARE CURRENTLY 232 ANIMALS IN THE CARE OF NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE WITH 71 IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
