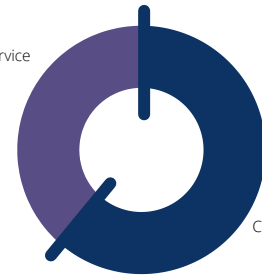

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A WEAPON IN THE AREA OF ROBINSON AND PORTER AVE ON 10/14. UPON ARRIVAL, OFFICERS LOCATED AND DETAINED THE SUBJECT. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATED THAT THE SUBJECT WAS NOT ARMED WITH A WEAPON.
- THE DEPARTMENT HOSTED NATIONAL NIGHT OUT AT THE SOONER MALL ON 10/14. THIS ANNUAL EVENT PROMOTES POLICE AND COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS, AND NUMEROUS LOCAL PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCIES, LOCAL BUSINESSES, AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH ENTITIES PARTICIPATED. THE EVENT WAS A SUCCESS AND BROUGHT MANY IN OUR COMMUNITY TOGETHER FOR THE EVENING.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO STOLE ALCOHOL FROM A CONVENIENCE STORE NEAR LINDSEY AND 24<sup>TH</sup> AVE SW ON 10/14. THE SUBJECT LEFT IN A VEHICLE. OFFICERS LOCATED THE VEHICLE DRIVING ERRATICALLY AND INITIATED A TRAFFIC STOP. THE SUBJECT FAILED TO STOP AND OFFICERS DISABLED THE VEHICLE. THE SUBJECT WAS ARRESTED AND TAKEN TO THE CLEVELAND COUNTY DETENTION CENTER.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 44 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 13 RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN 56 ANIMALS THIS WEEK. THEY CURRENTLY HAVE 226 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 74 OF THOSE ANIMALS IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
