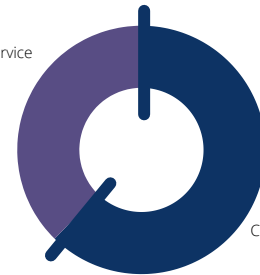

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF DISTURBANCE IN THE 1800 BLOCK OF WHEATLAND PLACE ON 10/24. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT SEVERAL JUVENILES WITNESSED A PHYSICAL DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE OCCURRING BETWEEN TWO ADULTS. WHEN THE JUVENILES ATTEMPTED TO INTERVENE, THE ADULT MALE BEGAN PHYSICALLY ATTACKING THE JUVENILES. THE JUVENILES WERE TREATED FOR THEIR INJURIES AT A LOCAL HOSPITAL. THE ADULT MALE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED ON BOTH DOMESTIC ABUSE AND ASSAULT CHARGES.
- THE PACE SECTION CONDUCTED AN UNDER 21 PROJECT WHERE OFFICERS FOCUSED ON BUSINESSES THAT SOLD NICOTINE PRODUCTS TO UNDERAGED INDIVIDUALS ON 10/22. DURING THE PROJECT, FOUR BUSINESSES ILLEGALLY SOLD THESE PRODUCTS AND WERE CITED.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 44 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 15 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 59 ANIMALS INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER THIS WEEK. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 213 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 77 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
