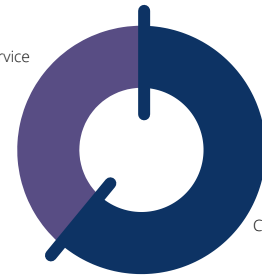

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A DISTURBANCE AT A BUSINESS IN THE 3700 BLK OF W. MAIN ST ON 10/26. INITIAL INFORMATION WAS THAT A SUBJECT WAS IN A PHYSICAL ALTERCATION, THREATENED OTHERS WITH A THE KNIFE, AND THEN FLED IN A VEHICLE. OFFICERS LOCATED THE SUBJECT WHO EVENTUALLY STOPPED BUT WAS UNCOOPERATIVE. OFFICERS ARRESTED THE SUBJECT FOR AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, DUI, ELUDING, AND OBSTRUCTION.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORTED ARMED ROBBERY IN THE 200 BLK OF REED AVE ON 10/26. A VICTIM REPORTED THAT A KNOWN INDIVIDUAL HAD STABBED THEM AND STOLEN THEIR PROPERTY. PATROL LOCATED THE SUSPECT A SHORT TIME LATER. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE VICTIM WAS ACTUALLY INTOXICATED AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT. THE VICTIM INITIATED AN ALTERCATION WITH THE SUSPECT AND ANOTHER PERSON, FORCIBLY TOOK THE SUSPECT'S BACKPACK, AND THEN ASSAULTED THE SUSPECT WHEN THEY TRIED TO RETRIEVE THEIR PROPERTY. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- DIVISION II OFFICERS GOT INTO THE HALLOWEEN SPIRIT ON 10/31 BY DELIVERING CANDY TO CHILDREN TRICK-OR-TREATING ACROSS NORMAN.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 22 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 13 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 64 ANIMALS INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER THIS WEEK. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 248 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 75 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
